

Ordinance 2009- 9

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT LAUREL,  
COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,  
AMENDING AND SUPPLMENTING CHAPTER 21 OF THE  
TOWNSHIP CODE, EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mount Laurel,  
County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1**

The Township Council of the Township of Mount Laurel, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey hereby amends Chapter 21, Section 4 of the Township Code of the Township of Mount Laurel, known as Emergency Medical Services, as follows:

**§ 21-4. Billings to insurance companies and/or persons served; fees.**

The Township of Mount Laurel shall contract with a professional medical billing service for the collection of payment for services rendered by the Mount Laurel EMS services. Said bill shall be issued to the insurance company for the person served, if any, or directly to the person served if insurance coverage is not available. Fees to be charged for Mount Laurel EMS services shall be as follows:

- A. For ambulance transportation: \$600;
- B. Per loaded mile for basic life support (BLS) mileage: \$14;
- C. Fee for oxygen administration: \$75;
- D. For automatic external defibrillator (AED) pads: \$75; and
- E. For cervical collars: \$25.

**SECTION 2**

All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as such inconsistency exists

**SECTION 3**


If, for any reason, any section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or illegal by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining sections hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4**


This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
